



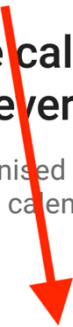

1) Open Outlook on your Android Phone, select “Add Account”



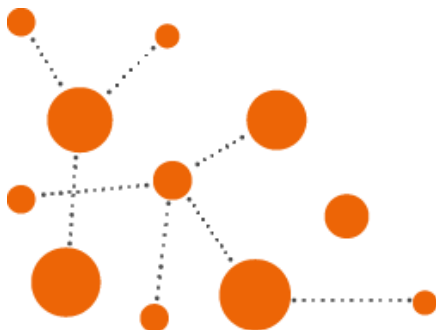
